October 2023 Paper Pumpkin Kit – Home for the Holidays Alternative Project Hershey Candy Bar Wrapper

Please note – if you don't have this Paper Pumpkin kit, you must be a current Paper Pumpkin subscriber in order to be able to purchase the Home for the Holidays Refill Kit that is now available in the store – item #163969 – if you are not, simply sign up today by purchasing a prepaid or monthly subscription and you can then purchase your refill kit by going to sarahsinkspot.stampinup.net and clicking on 'Shop Now' in the top left corner! If you are a current subscriber, you can purchase as many as you want whilst supplies last!



Take a 1.55 oz sized Hershey Candy Bar (the size you find in a 6 pack) and a landscape orientation card base from the Home for the Holidays Paper Pumpkin Kit:



Cut 1/2" off of the back plain panel. Put into your Scoring Tool with the printed panel to the left side – long edge along the top of your tool – and score at: 1 1/2", 1 3/4", 4", 4 1/4", 6 1/2" and 6 3/4"



Fold along all score lines with a bone folder and this is what you should have:



Wrap around your Hershey Candy Bar and use a piece of Tear & Tape to secure the flap at the back:



Take the long row of houses:



And trim 3/8" off of the bottom snow part:



Take the sheet of glittered labels and you are going to use your Paper Trimmer to cut off the very thin top section that is 'scrap':



Take that thin glittery section and use Fine Tip Glue to apply glue along the back:



And adhere to the bottom of the row of houses:



Adhere the row of houses onto the Candy Bar Wrapper using Dimesionals:



Stamp your sentiment and adhere in place using Dimensionals:



Apply Glitter Glue to the rooftops and windowsills of the houses and your Candy Bar Gift is ready for gifting!
