



DOOR HANGER HALLOWEEN TREAT

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Potions & Spells Stamp Set (164355)

Dies: Potions & Spells Dies (164141), Pocket Thoughts Dies (163552), Deckled Rectangles Dies (159173), Greetings of the Season Dies (164112)

BUNDLE OF STAMPS & DIES: Potions & Spells Bundle (164357)

Cardstocks: Black 12x12 (159231), White (159276), Granny Apple Green (146990)

Designer Series Paper & Sticker Sheet: Halloween Spells 12x12 (166610)

Specialty Paper: Window Sheets (142314), Berry Burst, Old Olive & White 12x12 Glimmer Specialty Paper (163769)

Ink: Granny Apple Green Classic Stampin' Pad (147095)

Ribbon & Twine: Black & Very Vanilla 3/8" Large Check Ribbon (161982), Baker's Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Black Stampin' Dimensionals Combo Pack (150893), Tear & Tape (138995), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Stampin' Seal+ (149699)

Using the largest die from Pocket Thoughts Dies cut out two shapes from black cardstock:



Cut a strip of black cardstock sized 12" x 1 1/2" and place into your scoring tool with a long edge at the top – score at 4 1/8" and 7 7/8":



Fold along all score lines and crisp them up using a bone folder:



Place strips of Tear & Tape adhesive on the flaps of one of the pocket pieces:



And adhere to one side of the strip of cardstock – make sure that the flaps go INSIDE the black strip for a neat finish:



Repeat for the second pocket piece:



Use the largest die from Deckled Rectangles to cut out a piece of black cardstock for the back portion of the box – adhere in place:



Use the next size down die from Deckled Rectangles to cut a piece of patterned paper and adhere in place:



If you do not wish to see the notch on the front of the box, cut a piece of black cardstock to measure 5" x 3 3/4" and adhere on top of the front panel:



Cut a piece of white cardstock for the back of the box so that you can write a note to the recipient:



Use a hand held hole punch to punch two holes in the top of the back panel:



Take a piece of ribbon and cut the end on an angle to make it easy to poke it through the first hole – poke through and finish with a double knot in front – cut to the length you desire your handle to be and repeat for the other side:



AND NOW YOU GET TO DECORATE!

I used papers from Halloween Spells DSP, die cuts using dies from the Potions & Spells Bundle and the bats are stickers from the sticker sheet...

TIP: to add a dimensional to a sticker without the edges of the sticker adhering to your project, simply pop on your dimensional and sprinkle over talc:



Dust off the excess, remove the backing paper of the Dimensional and adhere in place!
