### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

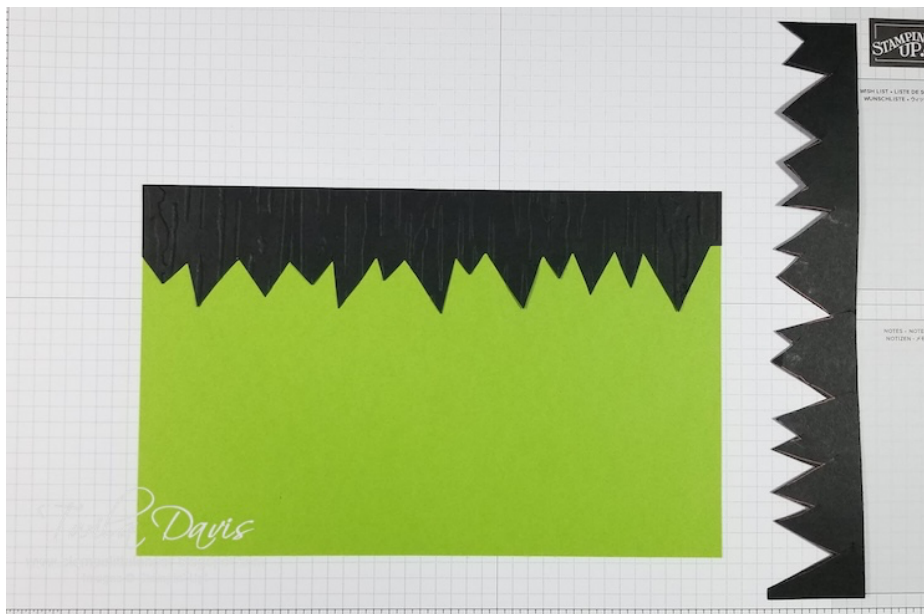
- Inks: Granny Apple Green (147095) Stampin' Write Basic Black Marker (162481), White Chalk Marker
- Cardstock (CS): Granny Apple Green (146990), Basic Black (121045) Scrap of Basic White (159276)
- Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Birch Wood 3D Emboss Folder (164069), Smallest Circle from Beautiful Shapes

Dies (158046), Smallest Circle from Round We Go Dies (163729), Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Tear and Tape (154031), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Sponge Dauber (133773), Pencil

- Miscellaneous: Package of Microwave Popcorn

## INSTRUCTIONS:

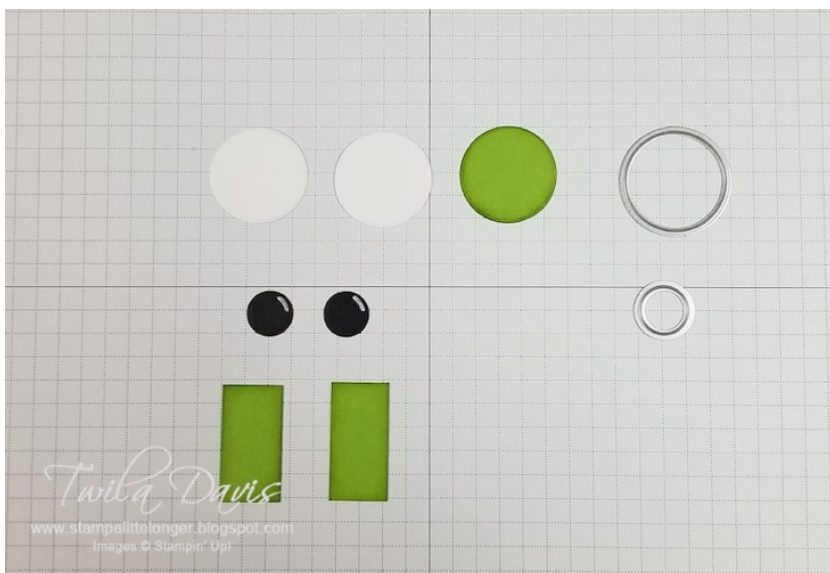
4. Cut a piece Granny Apple Green CS to 6" x 9 1/2". Cut a piece of Basic Black CS to 2 1/2" x 9". Using a pencil draw a jagged line down the 9" strip of BB to form hair. Using the Paper snips cut along the line. Wrap the "hair" around the popcorn sleeve to determine where it will be folded. Go ahead and fold it and run it through the machine using the Birch Wood Emboss Folder. Attach it to the green piece of CS as shown in the picture below using Mono Liquid Glue.



2. Flip the CS over and lay the popcorn pack in the middle. Add a piece of Tear and Tape to one side of the CS. Peel of backing and wrap the CS up to form a sleeve.



3. Cut out (2) White and (1) Green circle using the Smallest Circle Die from the Beautiful Shapes Dies, cut out (2) Black Circles using the Smallest Circle Die the Round We Go Dies. Cut (2) Green Rectangles to 1 ¼" x 5/8". Using a Dauber and Granny Apple Green Ink daub the edges of all the green pieces. Add highlights to the black circles with a White Chalk marker



4. Attach the eyes with Liquid Glue and adhere the eyebrows and nose with Mini Dimensionals. Add a mouth and some scars using the Black Stampin' Write Marker. Take the Dauber and Green Ink and daub around the sides of the sleeve to give it a little more depth. Now your project is complete and ready to give to a special little monster. Happy crafting!
