



FALL TEA BAG & CHOCOLATE SQUARE HOLDER

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Mossy Meadow (133676), Very Vanilla (101650), Crumb Cake (120953)
Designer Series paper & Stickers: Sweet Days of Autumn 12x12 DSP & Sticker Sheet (166609)

Plastic Pockets: 3x3 Flip Flaps Memory Protectors (166400)

Ribbon: Natural 3/8" Polka Dot Trim (163465)

Embellishments: Textural Elements (159966), Faux Glass Dots (164060)

Misc: Baby Powder, Handheld Hole Punch, Tea Bags, Chocolate Squares

Take however many Flip Flaps 3x3 Memory Protectors out of the package – I used 4:



You will see that they have an adhesive band at the top:



Take off the adhesive seal on the first and line up with one underneath and adhere in place – repeat so that you have a stack:



Pop your tea bag into the slit at the back of the first one:



And repeat until all pockets are filled:



Take a piece of cardstock and cut it to measure 4" x 9" – place into your score tool with a long edge at the top and score at 4 1/2" and 5 1/4"



Fold along score lines and crisp them with a bone folder:



And now you get to decorate how you wish!

When finished with decorating, peel off the adhesive strip from the bottom Flip Flap and adhere inside just beneath the score line. Add a strip of strong adhesive to the top Flip Flap and push the top scored flap onto it:



Punch two holes in the very top and thread through a piece of ribbon leaving a loop as the handle.

This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:
