Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Petunia Pop (163801)

Paper & Sticker Pack: Cute As Can Bee DSP & Sticker Pack (166618)

Dies: Hearts of Elegance Dies (164915)

Ribbon & Twine: Petunia Pop 3/8" Bordered Ribbon (163785), Gold Twisted Thread

(164603)

Embellishments: Adhesive-backed Heart Sequins (164920), Celebrate Love Mix &

Match Ephemera Pack (164857)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (149699), Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430)

Misc: Lindt Truffles, Handheld Circle Punch, Baby Powder

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 1/2" x 3"



Place in your scoring tool and score at 1" on all four sides



Cut four slits to create flaps and fold along all score lines



Place strong adhesive tape to two opposing flaps



Remove the backing strip and adhere in place



To decorate – cut a strip of patterned paper to measure 12" x 1"



Wrap around the box and push on the corners to create creases – use a bone folder to crisp up those creases



And then adhere to your box using strong adhesive tape



And fill with three truffles



Cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 7" x 3 1/2"



Place in your scoring tool with a long edge at the top and score at 3 1/8" and 4 3/8"



Fold along all score lines



Use a handheld hole punch to cut holes at the top and thread through the ribbon – tie in a bow to finish



Now decorate with your choice of images and sentiments! I chose to turn a sticker into an embellishment so that I could add dimension to it and this is how I did it – select your sticker and remove from the sheet



Turn upside down and attach dimensionals in place – BE SURE TO LEAVE THE BACKING PAPER ON!



Then sprinkle over baby powder (or corn starch) and smoosh in with your finger to make sure it is all covered – when ready to add to your project, remove the backing paper from the dimensionals and adhere in place!
