## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Daffodil Delight (119683)

Designer Series Paper: Floral Designs (164700), Storybook Moments (164662)

Sentiment: Greetings For All Mix & Match Ephemera Pack (164862)

Ribbon: White 3/8" Frayed Grosgrain (164205)

Dots: Glossy Dots Assortment (158827)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (154031)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Misc: Reese's Spring Sprinkles Big Cup

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 7 1/2" x 4" - place into a score tool with a long edge at the top and score at 1/2", 1 1/2", 4" and 5"



Turn around so that a short edge is at the top and score at 1"



Cut away the smallest panel to create a tab



Fold along all score lines and cut up to the intersecting score lines on the small panels to create tabs



Apply strong adhesive tape such as Tear & Tape to the long and small tabs, fold up and close to create a box – slide in your treat and decorate!
