Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Designer Series Paper: Wildflower Birthday DSP (164591)

Specialty Paper: Gold Foil (132622)

Cardstock: Basic White (166780)

Stamp: Market Goodness (163423)

Ink: Misty Moonlight (153118)

Die: Stylish Shapes (159183)

Embellishments: Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins (161627)

Adhesives: Tear & Tape (154031), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430)

Other supplies: Chocolate Eggs, Basket Grass

Take a piece of patterned paper and cut it to measure 6" x 6" – place into a scoring tool and score at 2" and 4"



Turn at 90 degrees and score the other way at 2" and 4" – this is how it will look:



Make 2 cuts down to the intersecting lines on each side



And fold along all score lines



Pull in two of the outer squares and line up at the corner tips – use tear & tape to adhere together



Use tape to adhere the square that is inside to the outer wall



This is what the inside will look like:



Repeat for the other side and there you have your basic basket!



Here is a look at the inside:



To make the handle cut a piece of cardstock to measure 7 1/2" x 1/2"



And use strong adhesive tape or a staple to adhere to each side of the basket – inside or outside – your choice!
