



GHIRARDELLI JACK O' LANTERN TREAT PACKAGE

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Basic Black (121045)

Designer Series Paper: Spooky Sweet DSP (166191)

Dies: Jolly Delivery (165844), Spooky Halloween (166198), Fright Night (166106). Stylish Shapes (159183)

Embellishments: Holographic Resin Dots (165598)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (154031)

Misc: Iridescent Treat Bags (166204), Ghiradelli Chocolate Jack O' Lanterns

Take a piece of patterned paper and use the treat package die from Jolly Delivery to cut out that shape



Fold along all score lines except for the top piece with the slit and the two little pieces each side of it



Place strong adhesive tape to the lower two 'wings'



Remove the backing paper, fold the pieces in and adhere the front piece to them



If you like the patterned paper that is on the back wall you can ignore this next step! I wanted a different pattern so I used the treat package die to cut out a different piece of patterned paper and cut off the sides and bottom, leaving just the center piece to slide into my package



Apply tape to the back, slide in and push down to secure in place being careful to line up the slit as you do it



As you can see two Ghirardelli Chocolate Jack O' Lanterns fit in there perfectly!



And now it's time to decorate! To create a see through circle to go behind the BOO I simply used a circle die to cut out a section from an Iridescent Treat Bag - you need to go through your die cutting machine a few times to cut through that plastic but I love how it turned out!
