



MINI COFFEE CUP GIFT CARD HOLDER

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Night of Navy (100867), Basic White (166780)

Designer Series Paper: Peaceful Garden DSP (165917), Peaceful Garden Glimmer (165929)

Stamp: Pine Tree Trimmings (166040)

Ink: Night of Navy (147110)

Embellishments: Hues of Blue Flowers (165930), White Bakers Twine (155475), Misty Moonlight & Silver Edged Ribbon (165931)

Tools: 2" Circle Punch (133782), Stylish Shapes Dies (159183), Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (154031)

Misc: 4 oz Mini Coffee Cup with Lid, Candies, Gift Card

For the box base: cut a piece of cardstock to measure 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" - score in at 1" from all four edges



Cut slits from the edge to the intersecting score line four times to create tabs



Apply strong adhesive tape and adhere in place



Turn over and your box base is done!



For the box insert: cut a piece of cardstock to measure 8 1/2" x 2 3/4"



Put a long edge at the top of your scoring tool and score at 1", 3 3/4", 4 3/4" and 7 1/2" - use a 2" Circle Punch to cut a hole in one of the larger panels



Fold along all score lines and apply strong adhesive tape to one of the end flaps



Fold together and adhere in place



If you wish you can use a glue dot to secure the front panel - do not do this at the back because you need your gift card holder to be able to slid in and out



For the gift card holder: Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 2 5/8" x 7"



Score at 3" and fold



Slide into the back of your box and you are now ready to decorate!



Take a coffee cup and cut open and gently flatten out - you will use this as a template. Draw around it on a piece of designer series paper



And cut out - test wrap it around your cup - you may need to trim more off of the bottom



Wrap around your cup and adhere in place
