Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Basic White (166780), Basic Black (121045)

Specialty Paper: Modern Christmas DSP (165990), Gold Foil Sheets (132622), Embossed Designs Mix & Match Cards & Envelopes (165358), Peaceful Garden Glimmer (165929)

Stamp: Pine Tree Trimmings (166040)

Embossing: Versamark Ink Pad (102283), Gold Embossing Powder (165678), Heat Tool (129053)

Dies: Ornamental Christmas (166000), Party Banners (165264), Stylish Shapes (159183)

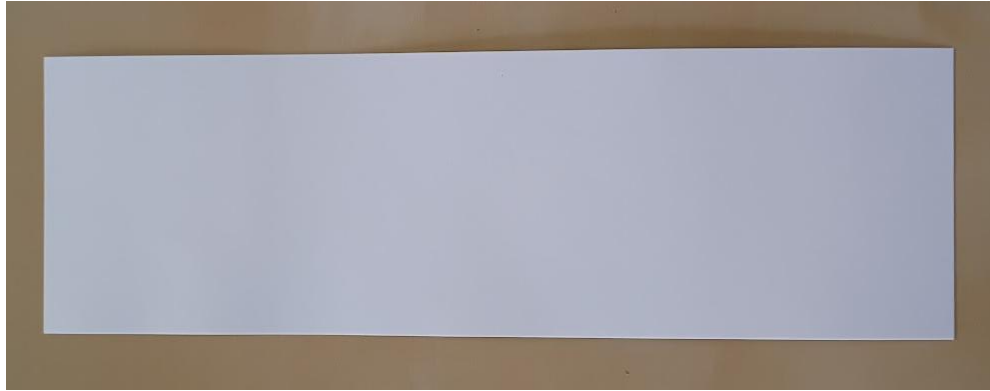
Embellishments: Traditional Sparkling Sequins (165875), Gold & Black Twine (166005)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

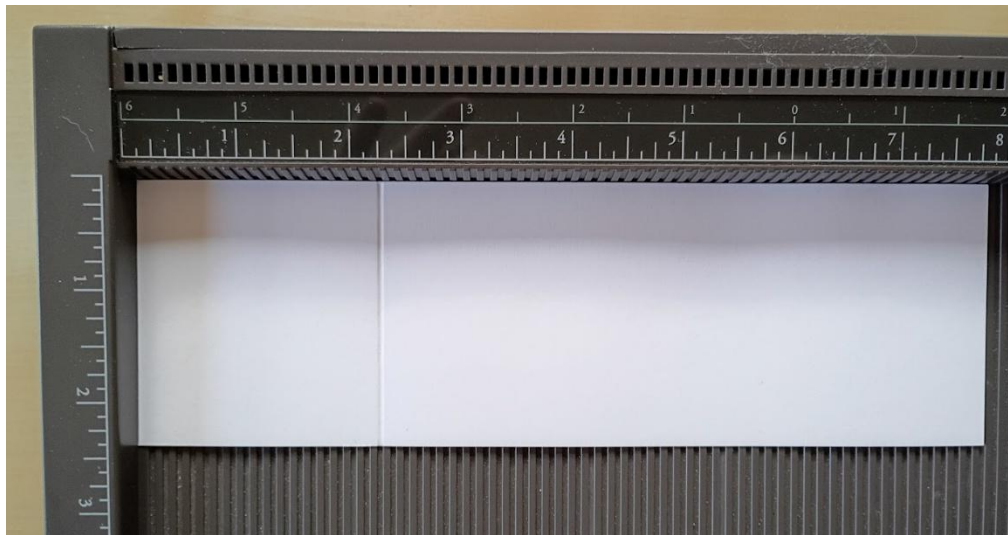
Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (138995), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Misc: Corner Rounding Punch, Bottle of Wine

Cut a piece of cardstock in the color of your choice to measure 8" x 2 3/4"



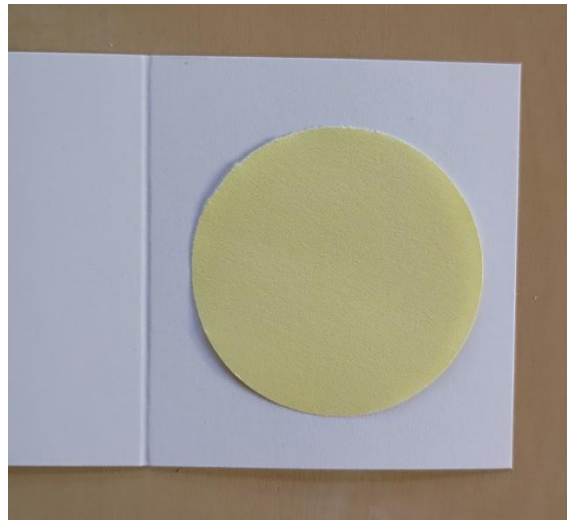
Place in your scoring tool with a long edge at the top and score at 2 1/2"



Take a 1 3/4" Circle Punch and use it to punch out a circle from a sticky note making sure to get a little bit of the adhesive in that punched out piece



Position centrally in the smaller section of your topper and adhere in place



Place your Circle Punch over it and punch out the circle to get perfect placement - alternatively you can use a Circle Die



And now you are ready to decorate however you wish!
