Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Basic White Thick 12x12 (166782), Pecan Pie (161717), Melon Mambo (115320)

Designer Series Paper: Made with Love (167054)

Stamp: Love Story (167065)

Ink: Early Espresso (147114)

Dies: Endless Love (167061), Paper Tags (165461), Stylish Shapes (159183)

Ribbon & Embellishments: Loose Valentines Assortment (167074), Misty Moonlight & White Starter Ribbon Pack (165276), White Bakers Twine (155475)

Tools: Simply Scored (122334), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (154031), Glue Pen (138309)

Misc: Lindt Chocolate Teddy Bear

Take a piece of 12x12 cardstock and cut it to measure 12" x 7 1/4"



Place in your scoring tool with a short edge at the top and score at 1 1/2" and 6 3/4"



Then place a long edge at the top and score at 1/2", 3", 6 1/4" and 8 3/4"



Cut a scrap piece of cardstock to measure 4 3/4" x 3 1/4" and score at 3/4" on both shorter sides and one longer side and set aside -



Trim as shown along the score line of the 1/2" top section leaving one tab which is on one of the larger panels - this will be the tab that you will adhere the top lid flap to. Trim the 1/2" tab on the side.



Take a large die and position on the front of the panel with the tab above it



Move it to your die cutting machine - you will need to fold up the bottom tab line in order for it to fit into your machine - be sure to put this folded line ABOVE the die so that you don't cut it! For extra protection I pop a scrap piece of cardstock on top of the die to reduce any marks.



Run through your machine and your front panel window is done!



Make slits along the bottom row of tabs as shown below.



Take that smaller piece that you set aside and trim the tabs as follows.



Apply a piece of very strong adhesive tape to the tab on the main box.



And carefully line up that small piece and adhere in place



Place strong tape on the bottom tabs and the side one and fold your box together making sure you push down well on the adhesive.



Pop your teddy bear inside to check the fit and you are ready for decorating!
